To our residents, family members and community,

As the situation with COVID continues to change, Maple Ridge Care Center and The Villas At Maple Ridge have decided to do a complete staff lockdown in our facility to protect our residents and their well being, as well as that of our staff. This decision was made after much discussion and thought by the Maple Ridge Care Center and Villas At Maple Ridge leadership teams.

I would like to also say that we DO NOT have COVID-19 cases in our building at this time. We are implementing these measures to reduce the risk of COVID-19 from entering our facilities.

What does staff lockdown mean? Our staff will work 7 days a week and stay in the building for 24 hours. After the 7 days, employees will go back home and quarantine in their homes for the next 7 days and then the rotation will begin again as long as Governor Evers' Safer at Home policy is in place.

We have received support for this plan from both Washburn and Barron County Public Health Departments, our corporate management company, and our medical director.

This plan will go into effect this Saturday, April 18th, 2020.
